SP—Speaker Meeting

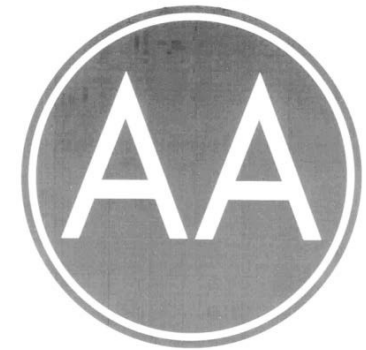
